Ronald "Jay" Davis was born July 24, 1919 in Hedrick, Iowa, the son of Charles W. and Jessie G. Kitterman Davis. He was united in marriage to Bessie Deborn August 1, 1942. He graduated from Hedrick High School in 1938 after which he worked as a farm hand doing odd jobs until enlisting in the U.S. Army in 1940. "Jay" served in the South Pacific during WW11, 6th Division, 80th Field Artillery Battalion in New Guinea, Luzon, and the Phillipines. He was discharged in 1945 and began working for Stevens Shoe Store in Ottumwa until 1947. "Jay" then worked at John Morrell in Ottumwa until 1974 when he retired. His hobbies included fishing and cheering for the Iowa Hawkeyes Football team. He was a member of the Bethany Baptist Church, and the Ottumwa V.F.W.
