Betty Lou Sheraden, 91, of Ollie died Wednesday, January 8, 2014 at the Jefferson County Health Center in Fairfield. She was born Tuesday, March 14, 1922 near South English in Keokuk County, the daughter of Clarence "Pat" and June Audrey Shipman Glandon. She attended school in the Webster area. Following school, Betty worked various places. On July 24, 1943, Betty was united in marriage to Alva Paul Sheraden and he died June 14, 1980. Following her marriage, Betty worked first at Downey's Prairie Home and
