Betty Lou Wonderlich, 81, of Sigourney and formerly of Ollie died at the Manor House in Sigourney. She always had a homemade snack ready for her kids when they got off the school bus. She was a member of the Ollie Baptist Church and had a very deep love for her Lord Jesus Christ. She enjoyed gardening, cooking, raising chickens and most of all caring for her family.
