



## Dale R. Schwartz

February 17, 1925 - June 8, 2024

Dale R. Schwartz was born to Louie and Lola Abrams Schwartz, on Tuesday, February 17, 1925, on a farm north of Hedrick, Iowa, just northwest of “Cracker’s Neck”. He attended a country school and went on to graduate from Fremont High School with honors.

On July 28, 1946, he was united in marriage to Betty Hensyel in Fremont. To this union four sons were born, Mitchel, Richard, Terry, and William. Dale worked together with his dad on the farm and eventually had his own farm. He developed a love for soil conservation which resulted in purchasing and operating his own bulldozer. This grew to doing many projects around southern Iowa.

Dale was an active member of the Christian Union Chapel where he served in many capacities including Elder and adult Sunday School teacher. Dale’s true loves in life were the Lord, his family, and his farm. He wrote a book incorporating events of his life into a humorous account titled “Watch the Cow Tillie”. It became a family project to get it published.

On Saturday, June 8, 2024, Dale passed away peacefully surrounded by family at the age of 99.

Dale’s family includes four sons and their wives: Mitchel and Laurel Schwartz of Eagle, Idaho, Richard and Gayla Schwartz of Ames, Terry and Katheen Schwartz of Pueblo West, Colorado, William and Carolyn Schwartz of Hedrick. He was blessed with fourteen grandchildren, thirty-three great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife Betty on October 7, 2020. He was also preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Mildred Hart and Anna Brophy; and a brother, Melvin Schwartz.
