Dennis Paxton, 65, of Fremont, died Friday, March 24, 2017, at Ottumwa Regional Health Center in Ottumwa. He was born Monday, May 28, 1951, in Iowa City, the son of Merle and Geneva Van Orsdall Paxton. He graduated from Fremont High School with the Class of 1970. Following school, Dennis worked at Oskaloosa Engineering for several years and at Fremont Elementary School for many years. He loved turtle trapping and was an avid Iowa Hawkeye fan. He also enjoyed attending his nieces and nephew's activities and pestering his family.

Dennis is survived by his three brothers: Terry (& Nancy) Paxton of Oskaloosa and Rodney and Norman Paxton both of Muscatine; a sister: Debra Paxton of Fremont; many nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews and a great great niece.

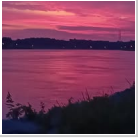
