Ernest worked for Budweiser, driving delivery trucks and also worked as a dealer for Liggett Myers Cigarettes. He owned and operated the DX Station in

After being involved in a motorcycle accident, Ernest was employed as a mechanic at the Carriker Ford Dealership where he was later shop foreman. He loved camping, riding motorcycles, mowing his yard, and pushing snow. Ernest was a volunteer for the Fremont Fire Department and Ambulance Service, and was a member of the Mahaska County Sheriff's Posse.
