Harold E. Brown, age 84, of Oskaloosa, died Friday, October 20, 2006 at the Marshalltown Hospital. He was born November 28, 1921, in Cedar, Iowa the son of Floyd D. & Pansy Rhinehart Brown. He was raised in rural Cedar.

Following his return from the service in 1945 he began farming the family farms with his father. He was united in marriage to Rosalie Bonnett on February 16, 1946, in Cedar. She preceded him in death April 23, 1996.

In addition to farming, he also did custom trucking and baling. In 1984 he and Rosalie moved to Oskaloosa. In 1999 they received the honor of having their farm become a Century Farm. Harold's enjoyments included Chicago Cubs baseball, playing City League baseball, raising horses, and spending time with his grandchildren.
