Harvey S. Black, age 85 formerly of Fremont, died Wednesday May 18th, at the Pleasant Park Estates in Oskaloosa. He was born on March 3rd, 1920 in Bloomfield, Iowa to Emery and Sarah Riggs Black. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1940 until 1946. On April 14th, 1944, Harvey was united in marriage to Marjorie Stice in Ottumwa. He was a drill press operation and maintenance man at John Deere in Ottumwa for 18 years and was also a member of the Ottumwa V.F.W. He had lived in the Ottumwa and Chilicothe areas before moving to Fremont in 1987.
