Jerry Dewayne Cowman age 62, of Delta died Wednesday, May 6, 2009 at his home in Delta. Family visitation will be held Saturday, May 9, 2009 from 2 – 4 p.m. at the Fremont Funeral Chapel in Fremont. Funeral services will be held Thursday, May 14, 2009, at 2 p.m. in the Delta United Methodist Church, at Delta, with Pastor Vince Homan officiating. He was also in the feed business, drove trucks, and worked at Good Year Tire Company. In October of 2008, Jerry retired from Farm Service in Oskaloosa.

His hobbies included collecting John Deere Toys, woodworking, doing yard work, and watching NASCAR racing. He was a member of the Delta United Methodist Church, past member of the American Legion, and past member of different bowling leagues.
