John Dunaway, 94, of New Vienna, Ohio and formerly of the Sigourney, passed away Thursday, March 26, 2015 at the Dayton VA Hospice Unit. He was born Monday, August 16, 1920 in Ollie, Iowa, son of Charles Miller & Alicia Marie McLansborough Dunaway. Following high school, John joined the United States Navy where he completed flight training and fought in WWII. John was united in marriage to Ellen Bastiansean Dunaway. Following marriage, John worked as a carpenter in Minneapolis, MN. He moved back to the Fremont area in the 1960's where he farmed and did carpentry work, especially for Parson's College. He sold the farm and retired in the early 2000's. He still checked on the farm daily when he was living in Iowa and when he moved to New Vienna, Ohio, he checked on things at his daughter's farm. He loved Black Angus cattle, health and nutrition, reading western novels and his family. His favorite hobby was hard work. He was a member of the American Legion and early on was very active in the Methodist Church.
