John Maynard McKee, age 96, of Fremont, died Wednesday, April 26th, 2006 at the Ottumwa Regional Hospital. Funeral services will be held at 2PM on Saturday, April 29th at the Fremont Funeral Chapel with Reverend Marion McCoy officiating. Interment will follow at the Cedar Township Memorial Cemetery in Fremont where the Oskaloosa American Legion and VFW will give honors. Visitation will begin at 1 PM on Saturday, April 29th at the Fremont Funeral Chapel and last until the time of service.

John was born on June 2nd, 1909 in Frazeytsburg, Ohio the son of Egbert and Ollie Graham McKee. He was raised and educated in Frazeytsburg, OH and graduated from the Frazeytsburg High School in 1927. In 1930 John moved to Iowa and farmed near Kirckville. On April 24th, John was united in marriage to Susie Morgan in Eldon, Iowa. In 1968 he retired and moved to Fremont. John served in the Signal Corps during WWII. He was a member of the American Legion, Formal Lodge 442 of Kirckville, and the Amateur Radio Club of Ottumwa.
