Klara Lisbeth Sonner, 85, of Sigourney and formerly of Hedrick died on Friday, November 12, 2010, at the Manor House in Sigourney. She was born on Tuesday, April 28, 1925, at Konigsberg, East Prussia, the daughter of Otto and Berta Wichmann. During WWII she worked in hospital units caring for wounded soldiers. Following the war she worked in a clock factory making watches and clocks until moving to the United States in 1955. On September 6, 1958, Klara was united in marriage to Hubert Sonner at Hedrick, they later divorced. Following her marriage she worked as a nanny and a housekeeper.

Klara's family includes her son and his wife: Pete and Linda Sonner of Hedrick; three grandchildren: Ryan, Joanna and Jennifer Sonner; two sisters: Elsbeth Reinart of Washington, Iowa and Helga (& Waldie) Tober of Bowling Green, Ohio and two nephews: John (& Rebecca) Reinart of Fairfield and Mark (& Brenda) Tober of Bowling Green, Ohio.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her ex-husband: Hubert Sonner.
