Leland Glen Hintz, 74, of Des Moines passed away Sunday, November 30, 2014, at Taylor House in Des Moines after an extended illness. Leland was born August 30, 1940, the son of Walter and Alveta (McEwen) Hintz. He grew up in Hedrick, IA, where he graduated from high school in 1959. He graduated from William Penn College in 1963. Leland married Charlotte (Walker) of Rose Hill, IA, in 1965 and lived in Des Moines throughout their 49-year marriage,

raising a son, Craig, and a daughter, Tina. Leland retired from the Post Office after 30 years as a letter carrier. He also served six years in an Iowa National Guard Medic Corps. Leland was active in the Capitol Hill Christian Church as a deacon, as Sunday School Superintendent, as a Food Pantry delivery person, as a Memorial Committee member, and in other positions. He enjoyed vacationing in Branson, MO, especially seeing the Christmas and Veterans' Day shows. He also enjoyed attending and camping at the Iowa State Fair, a family tradition dating back to 1948.

Leland is survived by his wife: Charlotte Hintz of Des Moines; a son: Craig Hintz of Rose Hill, IA; a daughter: Tina (Scott) Cronbaugh of Raymond, IA; granddaughter: McKenna Cronbaugh, and other loved ones including a brother- and sister-in-law: Leland and Mary Walker of Cumming, IA.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his mother and father in law: Ruth and Raymond Walker; two sisters-in-law: Joan (Leland) Walker and Rhonda Walker; as well as a niece: Laura Walker.

A memorial service will be held Thursday, December 4, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. at the Capitol Hill Christian Church in Des Moines.
