Mr. Davis is survived by two brothers; Wayne and wife Rosemary Davis of West Newton, Massachusetts, and David "Jay" and wife Karlyn Davis of Sun City, Arizona, four sisters; Alice Jean and husband Ray Booze of Wheatland, MO., Kathryn Witt of Des Moines, Ruth Adams and Frances Pope both of Fremont, several nieces and nephews, and his beloved

dog "Cindy Sue." He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers; Charles Emery and Paul Davis.
