Marguerite Lee, 99, of Parsons, Kansas, and formerly of Fremont, died Tuesday, January 8, 2013 at her home in Parsons. She was also a member of the Sew and So and Just a Mere sewing clubs in Iowa. Marguerite enjoyed gardening, reading, painting and antiques. She was interested in people and their lives.
