Nancy Louise Cook, 78, of Hedrick died Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in Iowa City. She was born Monday, December 21, 1936 in Drakesville, Iowa, the daughter of Homer and Wilma Harris Lawrence. She attended school in Memphis, Missouri and graduated from the Memphis High School with the class of 1954. Nancy worked for a time in the office at JcPenny's in Memphis and the Bank of Memphis in Memphis, as well as National Bank of Burlington in Burlington, Iowa, First National Bank in LaVerne, California and lastly at Hedrick Savings Bank in Hedrick, Iowa for almost 31 years until her retirement in June of 2000.
