Neil Allen Hynick, 65, of Schofield, Wisconsin and formerly of Fremont, Iowa, passed away on Wednesday, January 28, 2015 in Connecticut. He was born Tuesday, March 1, 1949 in Oskaloosa, Iowa, the son of Homer and Lillian (Lappin) Hynick. He graduated from Fremont High School in 1967. Early on, Neil co-owned B & N DX. He went to work at Cedar Elevator, Morrell, and Wausau Homes. Still working at Wausau Homes in 1982 he moved to Wausau, Wisconsin. There he worked for WH Transportation and Krueger Wholesale. He also owned and operated his own trucks. In retirement, Neil was happy to help a friend by running a load wherever needed. On December 19, 1969, Neil was united in marriage to Agatha Walker in Fremont, they later divorced. To this union three daughters were born. Neil always lived life to the fullest!
