Norman Phillip Crow, 82, of Hedrick died Saturday, June 1, 2013 at the Iowa City V.A. Health Care Center in Iowa City. He was born Monday, March 23, 1931 in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the son of Everett and Delma Collins Crow. He attended school in Ottumwa. Following school, Norman worked in several grocery stores until joining the Navy. On October 10, 1951, Norman was united in marriage to Betty Penniston at the Nazarene Church in Ottumwa. He worked as the meat department manager at several grocery stores including Easter's Super Value and Benner's following his discharge. He later owned

and operated a laundromat, a truck garden, and an antique store and also as the mayor of Hedrick for a time. He was a member of the Hedrick American Legion Post #83.
