Norman Winn, 81, of Ollie, died Monday, November 4, 2013, in Ollie. He was born January 21, 1932, in Mahaska County, the son of Afton and Zola Woody Winn. He graduated from Ollie High School with the class of 1949. Following graduation he served four years in the United States Navy. Following his discharge he returned to Ollie.
