



## Stanley R. VanDePol

March 26, 1922 - December 2, 2006

Stanley R. VanDePol, age 84, formerly of Fremont and Oskaloosa, died Saturday, December 2, 2006 at Altoona Nursing & Rehabilitation. His body was cremated and no services are planned. He was born March 27, 1922 near Eddyville to Gerrit and Clare Roberts VanDePol.

He was raised on farms in the Cedar area and graduated from Cedar High School in 1941. On May 23rd, 1942 Stanley was united in marriage to Lena Mae Allsup in Junction City, Kansas they farmed west of Hedrick for twenty-two years. He was a member of the Hedrick Christian Church, and a member

of the Eagles Lodge.

Stanley and Lena Mae ran the Wagon Wheel Cafe in Fremont in the mid 1970's. He was employed as an over the road semi driver for Harold Dickey, Packwood, Kingsbury Homes in Sigourney, Wausau Homes, Ottumwa, and Ace Trucking of Des Moines, retiring in 1984.

In October of 2001 Stanley and Lena Mae moved to Oskaloosa. Stanley entered nursing care in April of 2006, and transferred to Altoona in September.

His memory is honored by his wife of 64 years, Lena Mae of Altoona, three sons, Ronald (Lyn) of Ankeny, Terry (Mary) of Altoona, and Stanley Alan of Lexington, Kentucky, five grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren, and a sister, Frances Evans of Greenbrier, TN. He was preceded in death by his parents, and a brother Robert (Mary Else), and a great-grandson, Braden VanDePol.
