Stanley Earl Vogel was born October 8, 1950 in Ottumwa, Iowa the son of Eugene and Lela Sutton Vogel. He was raised north of Martinsburg.

He was united in marriage to Cheryl Otley in Olathe, Kansas on August 24, 1973. They later divorced. He worked in Kansas City until 1981 and then transferred to the Albuquerque, New Mexico Air Traffic Control Center. In 1997 Stanley retired and since then has resided in the Hedrick area.

Stanley's memory is honored by his grandmother, Cleo Sutton of Hedrick; his father Eugene Vogel and his special friend, Joann Van Buskirk, both of Hedrick; two brothers, Roger Vogel and his wife Sandy of Des Moines, Iowa; Doug Vogel and his wife Leesa of Hedrick, Iowa; a sister, Barb Blomme and her husband Jerry of Memphis, Missouri; and nine nieces and nephews.

Stanley graduated from Pekin Community High School in 1968. He attended college in Ottumwa and Eugene, Oregon where he studied to be an Air Traffic Controller. He graduated from college in 1971 and began working at the Kansas City Air Traffic Control Center. At the age of 21, Stanley was the youngest Air Traffic Controller to ever work in the Kansas City Center.

His hobbies included draft horses, quarter horses, and trail riding.
