Vera was born in Ollie, Iowa the daughter of Isaac and Maude Carter Northup. She lived in Eldon for several years and attended a country school near Eldon. She was united in marriage November 27, 1927 in Ottumwa to Howard Weber. They lived on their farm in Ollie, until the time of his death in 1955. She lived in Sigourney from 1956 until 1992 at which time she returned to Ollie. Vera was united in marriage to Karl Fauth, June 20, 1959 he died in 1962.

She was employed at Bales Rest Home, and Dicks Department Store both in Sigourney. She was a farm wife and homemaker. She had resided at the Manor House Care Center in Sigourney for the past eight years. Her hobbies included her grandchildren, fishing and crossword puzzles. She was a member of the Ollie Baptist Church, a Charter member of the "Ollie I'll Be Seeing You Club", Grandmother's Club, Rebekah Lodge #262 in Sigourney, was a 50 year member of the Ollie OES, where she served as Worthy Matron, and was instrumental in starting the Ollie Chapter of OES.
