Virginia Dalbey, age 91, passed away on Monday, July 6, 2020 at The Haven in Ottumwa, IA. Virginia was born on April 25, 1929 at Butler, IA, the daughter of Maurice and Hazel Mae Rhoads Aldridge. She attended Prairie No. 6 country school and graduated from Hedrick High School with the Class of 1946. She was united in marriage to Floyd Richard Dalbey on March 26, 1949 in Altoona, IA. To this union, 5 children were born: Craig, Bryan, Paula, Lisa and Tracy. Floyd preceded her in death on January 19, 2013.

Virginia was a homemaker her whole life.
