Waneta Irene McNabb was born September 27th, 1910 in Mahaska County, Iowa the daughter of Robert W. Johnson and Jessie May Taylor Johnson. She was raised in the Rose Hill and Delta areas.

On December 24th, 1932 she was secretly united in marriage to Paul McNabb in Unionville, Missouri. Following their marriage Waneta stopped teaching

temporarily to have her children, but returned 10 years later to teach at the one-room Little Red Country School near Delta. From there she went on to Delta Community, What Cheer and Ollie/Pekin Community primarily teaching kindergarten until she retired in 1972.
