Wayne E. "Jack" Glick, age 79, of Hedrick passed away Tuesday, November 14th, 2006 at his home in Hedrick. Graveside services with military honors will be held at 1:00 PM on Friday, Nov. 17 at the Brooks Cemetery in Hedrick with Rev. Shirley Hoffman-Will of the Prairieview United Methodist Church officiating. Visitation will begin at 11:00 AM on Thursday, Nov. 16 at the Fremont Funeral Chapel with the family present from 6 to 8 PM Thursday evening. A memorial fund has been established in his name.

Wayne E. "Jack" Glick was born on July 18, 1927 in Moravia, IA to Troy Samuel and Grace Davis Glick. He graduated from Hedrick High School in 1945 and joined the U.S. Marines shortly afterwards. He served in China and was discharged in 1949. He started his own business, Jack Glick Construction, in 1950 which he operated for 55 years. Jack married Donna Sterling on April 10, 1955. They later divorced. Jack was a member of the Arendt-Bolin-Stubbs American Legion Post #83.

He is survived by his two sons, Mark (Jane) Glick and David (Lori) Glick, all of Hedrick; four grandchildren, Adam, Jeremy and Melanie Glick and Emily Ellis; two step-grandchildren, Heather Keller and Chris Anderson; a step-great-granddaughter, Calissa
